2022 REPORT CARD

On March 11, 2021 Dufferin County adopted the Dufferin Climate Action Plan, a strategy to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and build resilience to the impacts of climate change.

CLIMATE EMERGENCY DECLARATION

On September 8, 2022, Dufferin County Council passed a motion to declare a climate emergency, reaffirming the County's commitment to climate action.

With this declaration, Dufferin County is joining 644 Canadian municipalities and over 1,200 jurisdictions globally in acknowledging that climate change poses a serious risk to the environment, infrastructure, and people.

Launched the Youth Climate Activation Circle a volunteer program to empower Dufferin youth to advance local climate solutions
